Schoolcraft is a small town of about 1,700 located approximately 10 miles south of Kalamazoo on US 131. The school district encompasses all of Schoolcraft and parts of Texas Township, Prairie Ronde Township and the City of Portage. The district has one high school, one middle school, and two elementary schools. There are approximately 1100 students Kindergarten - Twelfth.

Graduates: Approximately 50-55% attend a 4-year college, 35-40% attend a 2-year community college or trade/technical school.

Curriculum: Schoolcraft High School offers a seven class period school day, five days per week. The school year is divided into two semesters comprising two nine-week marking periods each. Students receive ½ credit per semester for each successfully completed class.
