

Kalamazoo Community Foundation Scholarship

The Kalamazoo Community Foundation is currently accepting applications for scholarships to assist with post-secondary education. The scholarships are available, through a competitive application process, to Kalamazoo County students or students who attend a Kalamazoo County high school.

Complete eligibility criteria and application requirements for all scholarships are available online at www.kalfound.org/scholarships.

Applications for Kalamazoo Community Foundation scholarships are completed and submitted online, using eGRANT, the Community Foundation's Web-based scholarship application system. eGRANT enables scholarship seekers to apply for up to eight Kalamazoo Community Foundation scholarships using one online form and is accessed via the Community Foundation's Web site at www.kalfound.org/egrant. The deadline for applying is March 31, 2010.

The Kalamazoo Community Foundation administers a scholarship program that each year helps local students pursue their post-secondary education at colleges, universities and trade or technical schools. Since its founding in 1925, the Community Foundation has awarded more than \$20 million in scholarships and grants to 4,700 Kalamazoo area high school seniors, college undergraduates and graduate students.
