It is time to prepare for the 2011/2012 ski season. We are looking forward to lots of snow and good skiing!

1. **BUS TRANSPORTATION:** The school district is planning to provide transportation to and from Timber Ridge on Thursdays this ski season. There will be a flat-rate fee for each person of \$50.00. This fee will cover the cost for your son/daughter regardless of how many times we transport them to Timber Ridge. However, if a sufficient number of students do not sign up to ride the bus, Schoolcraft Schools reserves the right to decide not to offer transportation. If you pay the \$50.00 and the decision is made not to transport students, the \$50.00 will be refunded. The average number of Thursdays we have skied has been 8 times each year over the last 5 years. There will not be a lower transportation rate if your son or daughter rides only one way or to only one event. It is not necessary for you to pay the \$50.00 fee if you choose to provide your own transportation every time.

If your child will only be riding the bus one way we will need **written notification** in advance. You must also speak with the appointed "ski club advisor" for the evening if you will be picking your child up from Timber Ridge.

If your child will stay at the Upper Elementary until the bus leaves they must remain in the multi-purpose room. Please provide them with a sack dinner or money to purchase food at Timber Ridge as school does not provide a meal option. They will be responsible to clean up after themselves if food is brought to the Upper Elementary.

2. **SKI CLUB MEMBERSHIP IS OPEN TO ANY STUDENT AT LEAST 8 YEARS OR OLDER AND NO OLDER THAN A SENIOR IN HIGH SCHOOL ALONG WITH THEIR PARENTS.**
(College age children and other community members are not eligible for this club.) However, transportation will only be provided for students in 6th grade and above.
3. **ADULT CHAPERONES ARE NEEDED.** If you are interested in occasionally chaperoning on Thursday nights, we will have a limited number of adult chaperone passes available. These chaperone passes will provide a free lift ticket as well as a free equipment rental on ski club night. If you have never skied before, it is never too late to learn! Adult chaperones will be scheduled for specific nights and will be expected to be on duty from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. to assist with the following duties:
 - 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. - Assist students in the lift ticket and ski rental areas.
 - 4:30 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. – Be available on the slopes and in the lodge to monitor students and provide assistance as needed. Chaperones are also expected to be available to assist injured students who are taken to the medical station.
 - 7:45 to 8:00 p.m. – Complete a final check of all lodge areas, including the medical station, to ensure that students are prepared to return home.
 - 8:10 p.m. – Bus loads students and ski equipment.
 - 8:15 p.m. – Bus leaves for Schoolcraft.
 - 9:00 p.m. – Bus arrives at Schoolcraft Upper Elementary parking lot.
 - While Adult Chaperones will be expected to assist any student who needs assistance, these chaperones will not be expected to assume any direct responsibility for children 5th Grade or under. It is expected that younger children will be chaperoned either by a parent or another adult specifically designated by the child's parent.

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS YEAR'S SKI CLUB ACTIVITIES:

DAY AND TIME: We will ski on *Thursday* evenings. Schoolcraft Adult Chaperones will be on duty to monitor and assist students from 4:00 p.m. until 8:15 p.m.

LESSONS:

- Timber Ridge Ski Instructors will provide lessons during the **first three weeks** that we ski. All new skiers are encouraged to take lessons.
- If school is closed for any reason, lessons will not be offered. However, students may still ski between 10:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m. but you must provide your own transportation.
- If Timber Ridge is closed for any reason, the club cannot transfer the lost day to another day. If lessons are missed, they will be resumed the following week.

SKI SEASON MEMBERSHIP GUARANTEES: Only three nights of good skiing are guaranteed for these membership rates. The least number of nights/season we have skied is 7. We normally average 8-9 nights/season plus Christmas Vacation.

MEMBERSHIP IDENTIFICATION (I.D.) CARDS: The Timber Ridge Membership Card must be presented each ski club night. Students who have lost their Membership Card will be admitted with the presence of a Schoolcraft Adult Chaperone only. Lost cards can be replaced for a charge of \$14.00. Schoolcraft Ski Club and Timber Ridge should be notified as soon the loss is discovered.

CHRISTMAS VACATION: Students with membership cards will be allowed to ski free on *Thursdays* during Christmas vacation. However, students will not be allowed to utilize "rent-free" equipment during this time period because of the shortage of rental equipment.

(*Option #4 is for **parents only**, and not intended for use by older siblings.)

PAYMENT: Payment and registration forms are due in the school office no later than **Friday, November 11, 2010**

REFUND: A refund will only be made to students who are physically unable to ski during the first three visits. The amount of refund will be the total paid less one-third for each of the first three school scheduled days, less a \$10 service charge. A written confirmation from a doctor must accompany a request for a refund. Please note that Schoolcraft Schools does not refund the money... the refund must be obtained from Timber Ridge.

REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP CARD: Timber Ridge and/or Schoolcraft Community Schools reserve the right to revoke membership cards and terminate Ski Club privileges from any student for destruction of property or disorderly conduct, without refund.

Prepaid Memberships provides Lift and/or Rentals **FREE** on Thursday nights and may also be used to save 50% off the regular lift and ski rental rates, including Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

Package #1 – Lift Pass, Equipment Rental, 3 Ski Lessons and Membership Card **\$130.00**

Package #2 – Lift Pass, 3 Ski Lessons and Membership Card **\$100.00**

PLAN B: “PAY AS YOU SKI” - MEMBERSHIP CARD

“Pay as you Ski” rates apply not only on Thursday Nights, but also for any other times you wish to ski, including Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

Package #3 – Ski Lessons and Student Membership Card **\$14.00**
Students then pay \$14 for lift ticket and \$14 for ski rental, if needed.

Package #4 – Parent Discount Punch Card. **\$20.00**
Parents pay \$14.00 for lift tickets & \$14.00 ski rental Monday through Friday (non-Holiday) Parents pay \$20.00 for lift tickets Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. Ski rental will still be \$14.00 any day.
